- Once registered, children under 5 receive daily milk free of charge, after their 5th birthday parents are invoiced half termly by Cool Milk.


School Meals

Lunch is from 12.00 noon - 1.00 pm



Reception: from start to finish






How to help your child at home

- Home learning books.








Parents are invited to:
