UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE DURING TERM TIME:

It has recently been brought to my attention that we still have a number of families who are taking unsanctioned holidays during term time. This is then being explained as sickness absence when queried by school, even though adult's social media may clearly indicate otherwise. As you will be aware, we always ring if a child is absent from school and we have not been given a reason why. We have even encountered international dialling tones on telephones which have gone unanswered in some cases. This then puts children in a very difficult position when they are asked about how they have been feeling upon their return to school. Children find lying about their whereabouts impossible and it is unfair that they should be put in this position.
