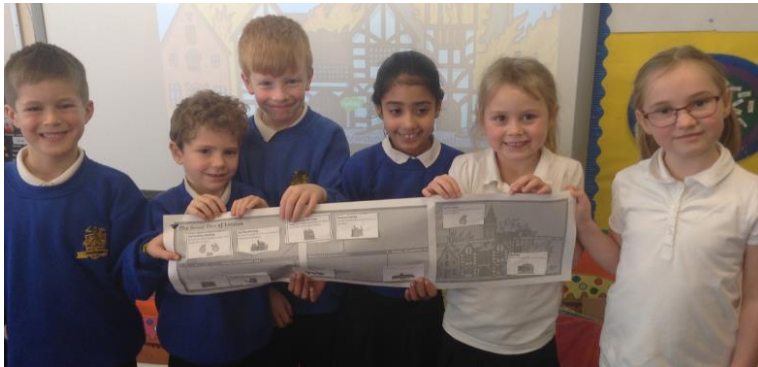
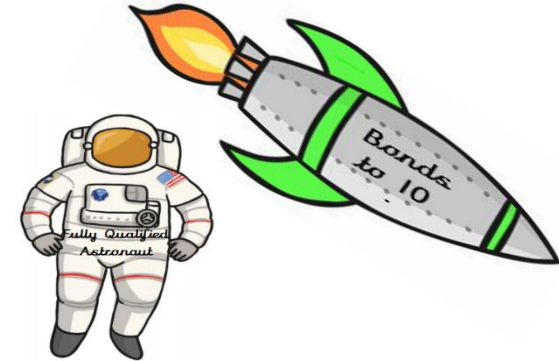


It has been a very busy term with our Castles and Dragons and London topics. Here are a few photos to show what happens in a Y2 classroom!
