

## Remote Learning baseline provision

### Year One

Live sessions	Each day the exact times for the lessons can be found on the Calendar function under MS Teams. You can join the lesson by clicking on join from the calendar. Be prepared to engage with the teacher.
Pre-recorded sessions/ recordings of the live sessions	Each class has a channel called Recorded Lessons, click on the top bar, on the class name. Under this channel you will find the pre-recorded sessions and the live sessions when the teacher has uploaded them.
Assignments	All assignments are uploaded the night before. We set a daily phonics, maths and literacy assignment. We set a weekly overview for Topic with an activity for each day. This is uploaded on the Monday and then they hand in all 4 activities on Friday.
Files	Class Materials: Extra maths sheets, handwriting practise, phonics resources,
Chat	We expect the children to use the posts/chat function to help each other when the teacher is not available. We do not expect children to place videos, emojis or silly chatter.
Marking and feedback	As a school we use a mix of individual feedback to ensure engagement and whole class "feedback not marking" to support collaboration, peer and self-reflection. In Y1 we feedback on every piece of work submitted. This might include what can be improved (eg) remember capital letters and a positive praise comment.
Deepening learning	Some children will require more work to provide them with a good level of challenge. In Y1 you can find extra handwriting and additional challenging math sheets in the files tab.
Supporting children	Some children will require more support to understand the concept or activity. In Y1 we ask the children if they want to stay on after a live lesson for more support or if they have missed part of the lesson. We also encourage the use of the chat function for any additional questions. For more support we have added links in the tabs at the top of Teams to RWI phonics, Letter Join and White Rose maths
