# Homework

- All children are expected to frequently read for pleasure. They will have a library book and a guided/independent reading book. They may also read a range of literature from home. Please read with your child and ask questions about what they are reading. Children are encouraged to read as often and as widely as possible. A menu of ideas can be found in the front of the reading record.
- Fluency of their number bonds will be developed and embedded through the space cadet program. From the Summer term fluency of tables and division facts of 2x, 5x, and 10x will be secured and extended using the TT Rockstars program.
- Spellings need to be practised little and often in order to improve fluency and embed their understanding. Each half term you will receive lists of spellings that your child is being taught in school. On Friday the children will have a “pop quiz” which will test their knowledge of the spelling rules and will review previous spellings that they have learnt.
