### Half Term Theme:

#### Literacy

Text for book week 'The day the crayons quit' by Oliver Jeffers and Elmer the Elephant David McKee.

### Mathematics:

We are going to be learning about the number 4 and looking at different ways to make 4. We are using Numberblocks to help us with this.



### Activities to do at home

- Practicing saying and forming the phonics sounds; m,a,s,t,i,p,d,n,g,o,c,k
- Practice putting coats on and zipping them up independently.
- Counting up to a group of objects up to 10, making sure each object is pointed to or touched or even moved into a line.
