Half Term Theme:

Mathematics:

We are going to be learning the values of each digit. For example; 1 is always 1. It can be a quantity, movement or action, object and position $\frac{1}{2}$ (1st). We are using Numberblocks to help us with this.

Activities to do at home

Playing I Spy, making sure you say the initial sounds. Play 'The Game of Nim' (See Below) To practise taking jumpers and coats on and off with no help!
