Charter of SMSC entitlement

Children attending Newburgh Primary School can expect the following in relation to their Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural entitlement:

- A personal curriculum reflecting the needs of their own community
- Stimulating, relevant educational visits, including residential
- Participation in school performances (large / small groups)
- Daily assemblies; acts of worship and prayer; monthly celebration assemblies; Vicars leading Christian themed assemblies
- Collaborative decision making (school council; house captains; eco team)
- Extra-curricular activities (from Reception to Year 6), eg, choirs, sports teams, cookery, arts etc
- Three basic rights: SAFE, RESPECT, LEARN
- A single school rule: consideration
