Dear parents and carers

We put on events for the school community – in recent years these have included film showings, bingo, camping weekends, quiz nights and of course the Christmas and Summer fairs.

The money raised by the PTA helps to support the school and enriches the environment and enjoyment for our children. Over the last few years we have helped to fund play equipment, computers, lockers, the refurbishment of the reception classrooms, subsidised school trips and much, much more.

Treasurer – keeps accounts and manages money. Makes sure we know what we have raised and don't spend beyond our means. Manages the bank account and deals with the school office for money transfers. This role lends itself well to someone with a background in finance or accounting, but that isn't absolutely necessary as our accounts are not complicated!

If you want to get involved, and help the PTA continue with its outstanding record at fundraising at the school, come along to the AGM. Without parents volunteering, there is no PTA.
