<u>Year 6 Outdoor Adventure Day – Bell Heath</u>

Dear Parents,

Year 6 will be visiting **Bell Heath, Boundless Outdoors** on **Tuesday 6th July** leaving school at **8:15am** and returning to school for approximately **5:15pm**.

We have created a bespoke program of events with the activity centre to ensure our Year 6 children have an unforgettable day of teamwork building, challenges and excitement. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a range of activities that would be similar to those experienced on a residential, **for example:** climbing, zip-wire, low ropes and grass sledding. The children will be split into groups to ensure that they have the support of experienced and qualified instructors at the activities alongside their usual staff from school. This is a unique experience for our Year 6 children.


The cost for the visit is £36.00 for each child, which is being subsidised by the PTA. Should this trip not proceed due to COVID related issues e.g. change in government advice or bubbles isolating, within 14 days of the booking. You will receive a refund of the amount paid, less a 25% deposit (£9.00) which is retained by Boundless Outdoors in line with their current booking terms and conditions.

Important information:

Uniform:	Activity clothing such as leggings, t-shirts and sweatshirts with a waterproof coat and suitable footwear for outdoor activities, such as trainers.
Lunches:	Please bring a packed lunch, and adequate drinks for the day OR please order a lunch via the online reply form.
Medial information/medication:	Please ensure all school records are up to date. Prescribed medication can be given during the trip, please hand it to a teacher in a clear plastic bag, complete with all prescribing instructions (e.g. pharmacist label). A permission form can be obtained from the office in advance.
Special Arrangements:	Suncream if needed, sunhat or warmer clothing and a waterproof coat.



















As with any trip we ask that children only join us for the day if they are generally well and not displaying any of the COVID symptoms. If during the day your child became unwell, we would ask you to collect your child from the centre and therefore we have asked for an emergency contact for this day.

The trip is being run in line with current government guidance and risk assessments. Measures are in place to ensure, as far as is practicably possible, the visit will remain COVID-19 secure. We have chosen as part of our COVID measures to only take school staff on the adventure day and therefore will not be asking for parent volunteers.

Children will not need any money to spend.
